Sunday 2nd February marks the completion of the EUPOL Criminal Investigation Training for the Attorney General's Office. This initiative was encouraged by Attorney General Dr Abdul Jabar Sabet and recommended at last June Rome Conference on Justice Sector reform.

The program was planned by EUPOL training advisors together with Kabul Police Academy experts and assistance from the Ministry of Interior.

The training started on the 24th of November and consisted on 200 lessons on Criminalistics, Criminology, Crime scene investigation, Criminal technique and evidence and Criminal tactics.

The theoretical lessons were complemented with practical training at the Kabul Training Academy by expert teachers with assistance of experts from the State Office of Investigations.

Visits to the State Office of Investigations, Central Department for Criminal Technique and the Kabul Medical University department of Medical Jurisprudence were carried out.

A total of 20 prosecutors from ten different departments attended the training. 17 of them have passed the training and will receive the certificate.

The participants have received:

- Basics in criminalistics and criminology
- Comprehensive package of the activities performed by the police at the crime scene
- Deeper understanding regarding handling evidence and avoidance of contamination
- Theoretical and practical training in handling murder cases, burglary cases, narcotics cases, traffic and blast incidents.
- Training in tactical investigation skills.

During the whole program they showed an high level of motivation and interest.

The EUPOL Mission is grateful to the Ministry of Interior of Afghanistan, the Government of Finland and the German Cooperation GTZ for the technical and financial assistance that has made this program possible.

“The development of relationship and interaction of MoI with the wider Criminal Justice Sector is one of our strategic objectives”, said EUPOL Commander General Juergen Scholz at the ceremony.
