Attorney General's Office and EUPOL Mission in Afghanistan:

Agreement Signed to Fight Corruption

To fight corruption within the Afghan National Police, EU Police Mission in Afghanistan has signed a letter of agreement with the Attorney General's Office on the establishment of Military Anti-Corruption Prosecution Unit.

A Military Anti-Corruption Prosecution Unit (MACU) will be established at the Attorney General's Office in Kabul under the supervision of the Deputy Attorney General / Military, General Fatah. Case selection criteria shall guide the military prosecutors in Kabul and in the regions on what categories of cases would have to be referred to the MACU.

EUPOL Afghanistan will assign mentors to and provide training for the MACU prosecutors. EUPOL will furthermore support the implementation of a case file management and an online case tracking system. EUPOL will also support the MACU with office equipment.
